# AN INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS: What you should know

- The ISSCT (International Society of Sugar Cane Technologists) holds its International Sugar Cane Congress every three years.
- This Society has 24 affiliated countries.
- SATCA (Argentine Society of Sugar Cane Technicians) is the local organiser and host.
- Representatives of 72 different countries are expected to attend.
- The average number of attendees is approx. 2,500.
- More than 400 papers were submitted, exceeding the historical number.
- The history of sugar cane production in Argentina has almost 3 centuries.
- This event will be held in 3 provinces in the north of Argentina: Tucumán (Pre Congress and Congress) and Salta/Jujuy (Post Congress).
